Erie County Notification System implementation

The Erie County Emergency Management Agency is proud to announce the implementation of the Erie County Notification System. The Erie County Notification System provides emergency notifications, general notifications and alerts to participants all across Erie County via text, e-mail or voice message. Those registering can choose which notifications and alerts they would like to receive including information about severe weather from the National Weather Service, winter road condition advisory levels, emergency notifications and Community specific messages from participating entities. Individuals can easily opt out of this service at any time simply by texting STOP after receiving a notification message and they will be removed from the system. We urge people to assist setting up family members or friends who are without internet access. Those individuals can still receive phone calls to landlines which could help them during an emergency. The registration form also allows users to give information about disabilities or special needs they have that could be utilized by emergency services personnel during a disaster.
